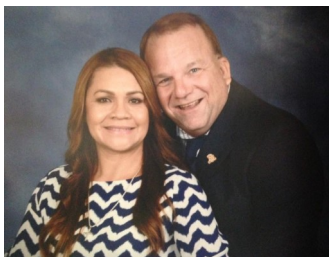
Polly and Stela also made 4 large cakes, cut them into pieces, wrapped and handed them out!



### **MOTHER'S DAY ITUA!!!**

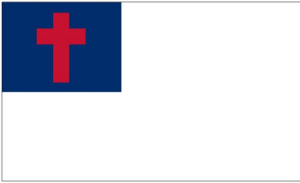

### Chapeu de Palha !!!

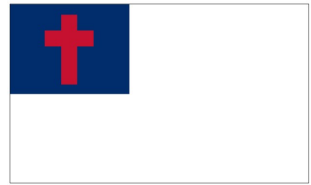
Stela and I have donated a new structure on the ARM property ACAMPAMENTO LUZ DA VIDA!!!

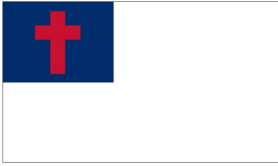
It is called a Chapeu de Palha and will serve many purposes. Mostly for the over crowding we are now having on the Luz Da Vida during Bible Classes which puts more at risk during this covid in Brazil. Even though we increased to two classes, those

classes have over flowed the capacity of Luz Da Vida.

So we built an 8 meter by 8 meter palm structure that can handle many more students. It will be much more spacious and has easy access . The flooring is cement and the timber is iron wood, with 400 palm branches for covering. It took about two weeks to build, three

days to dig out and level by hand. There was a lot of dirt to move and a big bulk head to fill in!! Praise the Lord, we had men working for us to do the job – building the frame and mixing the concrete all done by hand!!! It was a tough job these guys did! Hats off to Daniel and 4 others that took on this project for us!!

- In-Touch Messengers, which are a solar powered pre-programed Bible in Portuguese with a radio and flashlight, are provided without cost to villagers. Many of the villagers can't read or write and this is a proven useful tool.
- Stela teaches the illiterate of all ages to read and write including tutor programs for children and youth which are accredited by the University State of Amazon.
- We have Bible study groups and discipleship classes.
- Bible English classes which teach villagers English through verses of the Bible.
- Programs through Spiritual Based Teachings of the gift of Salvation by Jesus.
- Fellowship Events, Youth and Children's Camps
- Short Term Mission Teams

The A.R.M Ministry Team is living full time on a River Mission Boat (LUZ DA VIDA) spending quality time and spiritual effectiveness in very difficult-to-reach areas of the Amazon River Basin. These unreached people groups in villages and homesteads along the river banks can only be reached by boat.
