Bible English Class 2022

Bible English Class 2022 is centrally located at Camp Luz Da Vida on the Sanabani River, serving up to 8 communities outside the city of Silves. Students learn to speak English through the Bible by studying basic English, verse memorization, and music. The students range from

6 years of age and up.

This is a 40 hour course, and students will receive one credit hour from our local college and a certificate from Amazon River Missions.

ARM provides the English books written by Todd & Stela Moore to follow God's gift of salvation!

The focus of this project is not English, but to have students learn and understand more about Jesus!



Bible Study 2022 The Book Of Luke

Bible Study, The Book Of Luke 2022 is open to ages 4 and above.

This project is to teach students more in depth about the Bible and what each Book of the Bible has in store for us!! Students love this course because it is challenging and requires reading and understanding of each Book. The little ones love the Bible crafts and coloring their Bible stories! The ARM Ministry Team is teaching the word of God through various resources.

- In-Touch Messengers, which are a solar powered preprogramed Bible in Portuguese with a radio and flashlight, are provided without cost to villagers. Many of the villagers can't read or write and this is a proven useful tool.
- Stela teaches the illiterate of all ages to read and write including tutor programs for children and youth which are accredited by the University State of Amazon.
- We have Bible study groups and discipleship classes.
- Bible English classes which teach villagers English through verses of the Bible.
 - Programs through Spiritually Based Teachings of the gift of Salvation by Jesus.
- Fellowship Events, Youth and Children's Camps
- Short Term Mission Teams

The ARM Ministry Team is living full time on the Sanabani River at LUZ DA VIDA Mission camp, spending quality time and spiritual effectiveness in very difficult-to-reach areas of the Amazon River Basin. These unreached people groups in villages and homesteads along the river banks can only be reached by boat.

We ask that you keep us in your prayers and partner with us to reach these unreached people by taking to them the Light Of Life, Peace, Mercy and Grace through the Word of God, Baptizing them in the Name of The Father, The Son, and The Holy Spirit as commanded by our Lord and Savior Jesus.
