
Retaining wall started!

The much-needed retaining wall work has started which will protect our home from torrential rains and erosion. The workers have dug out the grade needed for the rain water to travel to its intended drainage to the river, minimizing erosion along the way! As most of you know, you do not want water standing or flowing on the ground around your home because it could leave the foundation soft and could cause unwanted settling.

Praise the Lord we were blessed with the funds needed to start and complete this project. We cannot thank you enough for following God's leading!

We are about 55% complete. The work has been a little slow because of heavy rains and a shortage of sacks of cement in the city of Silves.

Prayerfully this project will be finished by Christmas!





The ARM Ministry Team is teaching the word of God through various resources.

- In-Touch Messengers, which are a solar powered preprogramed Bible in Portuguese with a radio and flashlight, are provided without cost to villagers. Many of the villagers can't read or write and this is a proven useful tool.
- Stela teaches the illiterate of all ages to read and write including tutor programs for children and youth which are accredited by the University State of Amazon.
- We have Bible study groups and discipleship classes.
- Bible English classes which teach villagers English through verses of the Bible.
- Programs through Spiritually Based Teachings of the gift of Salvation by Jesus.
- Fellowship Events, Youth and Children's Camps
- Short Term Mission Teams

The ARM Ministry Team is living full time on the Sanabani River at LUZ DA VIDA Mission camp, spending quality time and spiritual effectiveness in very difficult-to-reach areas of the Amazon River Basin. These unreached people groups in villages and homesteads along the river banks can only be reached by boat.

We ask that you keep us in your prayers and partner with us to reach these unreached people by taking to them the Light Of Life, Peace, Mercy and Grace through the Word of God, Baptizing them in the Name of The Father, The Son, and The Holy Spirit as commanded by our Lord and Savior Jesus.
